When you type your bibliography or works cited page, list your sources in alphabetical order by author's last name.

Use hanging indent for each citation.

If no author given, begin entry with title of article.

If two authors: Beck, Charles, and Bernard Sales.

If an editor: Larkin, Deborah, ed. / **If editors:** Ross, Jay and Kay Brown, eds.

Book title should be underlined, using title case capitalization.
